## ... things that go "itch" ...

here we go again ... red spotted logs have been showing up at the Marina ... time for the annual article on Swimmers' Itch.

### FAQ's ... on swimmers' itch:

What is swimmers' itch? ... it's a skin rash caused by an allergic reaction to parasites that migrate from snails to ducks, geese, muskrats and beavers. Swimmers' itch in people is caused when this parasite enters a persons skin rather than their natural hosts. Since people are unsuitable hosts, the cercariae quickly die., but can cause an allergic reaction in some people. Unfortunately, about 1/3 of people who come in contact with the parasite develop "itch".

TRUSTEE MEETING

HIGHLIGHTS: Trustee Meeting, May 8, 2010

- The Ziglinskis reported that 110 reservations had been made for the spring dinner at the golf course.
- Treasurer Tom Berreman passed away last November. He noted that there are a number of others who have been diagnosed with serious illnesses.
- With respect to the lake monitoring, Mort Mortensen and Mark Jacobsen may be helping.
- A great deal of work was done on the lake plans during the winter months. The Sewer District has been particularly active.
- Nelson noted that Cedar Lake's aeration program, of about 5 years, has not seemed to help with the green condition of their lake. Jim Miller of the Deer Lake Conservancy reported at a Sewer District meeting on its program to acquire properties adjoining the lake; Deer Lake water clarity is in the 25 foot range.
- Eurasian milfoil has been found in Pike Lake, which means it will also be present in North and South Twin lakes.
- Wapogasset Park is trying to obtain money for the playground—a slide and a merry-go-round. There is a \$7500 grant from Bremer Bank.
- Both Garfield and Lincoln ban the burning of leaves near the lake because the phosphoric ashes create acid. Marlin Baillargeon, a neighbor on 100th Avenue, will pick up leaves for a fee. (Phone: 268-2530).
- Membership. Lake Association membership currently numbers around 200.
- Water Patrol. The arrangements for water patrol are the same as last year – patrol by the sheriff's department, shared with the Pine, Round, Church Lake District.
- Clean Boats/Clean Water. Rick Bazille reported –

this is the third year of operation – the program covered 93 hours the first year, 243 hours in 2009. A DNR grant will help finance 5 young Amery high school inspectors, plus volunteer hours.

- Flares will be available in June at Larry Karlson's storage shed on County Road C. See Mary Lou Stanley.
- 300 Club. A great many tickets remain for this year's 300 club. Mary Lou will be selling them at the Lake Association dinner. Trustees are asked to contact Mary Lou for tickets and to sell them promptly. A suggestion was made that the distribution of the Lake Scene on Memorial Day weekend would be a good time to sell.
- Neighborhood Watch. Jerry Tessman reported that a new order of metal signs had been received. Trustees were asked to check existing signs in case they needed to be replaced. (268-6570)
- Comprehensive Lake Plan and Aquatic Lake Plan. Copies of both are available at [www.wapobear.com](http://www.wapobear.com). Dave Nelson was to check whether a copy of the lake plan could be made available to the public at the Amery Area Library.
- Curlyleaf Pondweed. Nelson reported that Bear Trap areas were sprayed May 6 and Wapogasset was scheduled as soon as there was a calm day before the temperature goes to 58 degrees. Motion/Second that the Association pay one-half of the cost of the curlyleaf pondweed spraying. Unanimous by voice vote.
- Carp Derby. No information available yet as to whether it will occur this year.
- Habitat Assessment. Joe Ziglinski explained that this project was delayed last fall and will resume this spring. It is part of the comprehensive lake plan and is necessary for the DNR to accept out plan. Mark Jacobsen volunteered to help. Other volunteers should contact Joe.
- Jeremy Williamson of the County Land and Water Resources Department has asked for help in monitoring zebra mussel traps. Rick Bazille volunteered.

# ITCH ... ITCH ... ITCH continued from pg. 1

*Is it dangerous?* ... No ... the allergic reaction can be really annoying, but it is not dangerous... no other parts of the body except the skin are affected.

*Is it "catchy"?* ... NO ... it isn't contagious from person to person.

*What are the symptoms?* you may feel a "tingling" sensation after emerging from the water ... red spots will appear ... then after an hour or two the tingling will stop, red spots will enlarge and become itchy. Spots reach their maximum size after about 24 hours.

*How long will it last?* 4-5 days ... but can persist up to 2 weeks. Sensitivity can increase each time you're exposed to the parasites.

*How do I control the itching?* Use over-the-counter topical antihistamines or anti-itch creams, such as those that contain calamine lotion. I received an email from someone who had good luck with oral antihistamines (Benadryl dissolve strips) and uses Bull Frog "mosquito coast" sunscreen/with insect repellent BEFORE going in the water. If the itching is severe, your doctor may recommend a prescription medication.

*Are there any home remedies?* you might try to soak in a bath sprinkled with Epsom salts, baking soda or oatmeal ... or ... stir water into baking soda until it makes a paste and then apply to the affected areas.

*Does Swimmers' Itch last all summer?* The first outbreaks usually occur in late May or early June. The outbreaks may last from 2 weeks to a month, however, in some lakes it may last the entire summer.

*Is there any way to prevent the "itch"?* Avoid swimming when there is a strong on-shore wind ... stay out of shallow water ... liberally apply a fragrant suntan oil before swimming ... immediately after leaving the water, rinse off and vigorously dry your skin with a towel ... DON'T feed the ducks ...

*Are there any complications?* If you scratch the rash too harshly, it may lead to infection ... see your physician if this happens.

*When to consult a doctor?* If you have a rash that lasts more than a week. If you notice pus at the rash site.



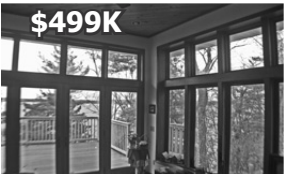
