stroller ... JUST COME! Be sure to come EARLY ... the road in to the Camp is narrow and lots of people and vehicles will be coming and going! Parking attendants (watch for orange t-shirts) will direct you. If you didn't have a chance to register at the Spaghetti Feed, you'll have a chance to do it from 8a to 9a. 2 mile and 10 K runs begin simultaneously and start at 9:00 a.m.



SOUR CREAM CHICKEN ENCHILADAS

2 Thsp. olive oil

1 Tbsp. butter

1 medium onion, choped fine

1 4oz. can green chilies

Cilantro, chopped

3 cans cream of chicken soup

116oz. sour cream

1/2 tsp. salt ... course ground pepper

3 cloves garlic

3 cups shredded cooked chicken

10 - 7" flour tortillas

2 cups shredded Sharp Cheddar

Optional: 2-3 jalapeno peppers finely chopped ... Preheat oven to 350 - Spray 9x13 pan. Heat oil and butter, add onion, green chilies, cilantro, soup and sour cream (& jalapenos). Cook 10 min. Stir in chicken - season with s&p. Spoon ~1/3 cup sauce on each tortilla - roll up and place seam side down. Pour remaining sauce on top and sprinkle w/cheese. Bake 30 min until sauce is bubbly. Rest 10 min.

- Follow lighting directions on the flares.






