
We are sking for winter wear for school-age children grades pre-K to Grade 12.



Caramelized Onion Stuffed Baked Potatoes

2 medium baking potatoes

1/2c. (2 oz) Gruyere cheese divided

2T reduced sour cream

1/2 t. salt

1/4 t. black pepper

1-1./2 t butter

2 cups vertically sliced red onion

2 tsp. sugar

1 t. worchestershire sauce (+ some sherry)

1/2 t. dried thyme

1 clove garlic minced

... Pierce potatoes - micro 10 min. - let stand 5 min.. Cut potatoes in 1/2 lengthwise, scoop out pulp - combine with sour cream, 1/4 c cheese, salt/pepper - put back in shells. Melt butter - add onion, sugar and saute 8 min. Stir in sherry with worchestershire sauce, thyme, garlic. Cook 1 min. Top potatoes with onion and cheese - micro 1 min.
